Kamba Gallery is honoured to support the Society of Black Lawyers in the creation of a special exhibition to commemorate Black history month and the 40th anniversary of the Society of Black Lawyers the event will be hosted by law firm Fasken Martineau, Hanover Square.

The exhibition will be a combination of tribal and contemporary pieces that document Africa's rich and diverse history and celebrate new emerging talent. Exhibited works for sale will include Contemporary paintings and sculptures and Tribal masks, jewellery and figures from the 19th and 20th Century.

Michael Soi - South African artists based in Kenya creates works based around political and social satire **Kiboko** - London based Kenyan artist know for his Afuranga illustrative style

George Lilanga - Tanzanian artist inspired by the Mapico dance and associated sculpture, which embody movement in space, caricature and social criticism.

Emmanuel Okoro - London-based sculptor originating from the Delta Region of Nigeria. His sculptures are informed by his interest in storytelling and themes of tribal ancestry, humanity, legacy and immortality.
